# IMPORTANT: All youth must pass the Walter Baker swim test.

- The swim test requires the youth to swim one lap of the lap pool without touching or stopping, without a lifejacket.
- Every year, parents send youth who cannot pass the swim test.
   This risks the youth's safety.
- If the youth does not pass the swim test, they will not be allowed in the pool. Please talk with the parents in advance.
- Leaders remain responsible for ratio of their youth.
- Leaders can watch from the sideline, or the leaders can swim. Your choice.
- Walter Baker lifeguards will look after the youth while in the pool.
- \$15 per youth. No cost for leaders.
- Leaders are responsible after the event to supervise their youth until the youth are returned to the parents.
- There will be a station where youth can work towards passing Level 1 Aquatics. This station will not provide instruction but rather only test the youth. Youth will be given a sheet to provide to their leader indicating which requirements they have passed.
- Parents watch from the second floor observing windows.
- If a youth in your section has a medical condition that we need to know about, please tell us before the parent gets upset, not after.
